## HOW IT ALL STARTED

A historical overview of our ministry and facility is important as it brings understanding of why we do what we do. It also spot-lights the miracle working God who has brought us where we are today. We would be presuming greatly on His mercy if we did not daily acknowledge Him as our source of strength, wisdom, material blessing, success with campers, decisions, and even life itself. From the beginning, "To God be the Glory" has been our theme song.

**Chuck Chastain and Walt Brock**, with the help and support of their wives, Sarah and Betty, founded Ironwood. Early in 1972, these two men met together on numerous occasions to discuss and pray about beginning a camp ministry. In the spring of 1972, the Chastains and Walt looked at this property. Through prayer for wisdom and help, investigation, periods of despair, and periods of optimism; God answered prayer and allowed them to assume control of the property on January 1, 1973.

When the owner of the property would not sell to a non-profit corportaion, Walt Brock, Chuck Chastain, John Brock, and Lee Brock formed a partnership called Triple B-C Ranch to purchase the property. In 1973, they also formed a nonprofit corporation called Fundamental Christian Endeavors Inc. (FCE), to operate the camp. After several years, John and Lee were unable to continue to participate with the Triple B-C Ranch, but stayed on the board of FCE. In 1986, after the land was completely paid off, Triple B-C Ranch donated all of th land and assets to FCE and was dissolved, making it possible for Ironwood Camp (FCE) to become sole owner of the entire 185 acres and all the facilities.
